EARLY ADMISSION GUIDELINES

The following procedures will apply to full-time admission candidates attending college in their senior year.

1. It will be the responsibility of the student to select courses appropriate for any remaining graduation requirements and have them approved for high school credit.
2. It will be the responsibility of the student to provide for his/her tuition costs, transportation, and fees.
3. The student will submit a completed application for early admission to the guidance office.
4. Only courses necessary for high school graduation will be transferred back to Johnstown High School for determination of rank in class.
5. A semester course at college equals a semester course at high school.
6. The following conversions will be utilized for purposes of determining final course average and awarding units of credit at Johnstown High School:

A+ = 97 B+ = 87 C+ = 77 D+ = 69

A = 95 B = 85 C = 75 D = 65

A- = 91 B- = 81 C- = 71 F = 60

7. Students participating in this program will not be recognized on the Johnstown High School Honor Roll.
8. Students participating in this program will not be considered as full-time high school students and, therefore, will not be eligible for Valedictorian and/or Salutatorian honors.
9. Upon successful completion of the early admission year and an assessment of the respective credits to be awarded by Johnstown High School, the student may participate in the regular Johnstown High School graduation ceremonies.
10. It will be the student's responsibility to be aware of ALL information related to senior year activities.
