MS Adolescence Education Apprenticeship Program (Certificate area specific, Grades 7-12) 38 Credit Hours

This is a graduate program designed for candidates who possess a Bachelor's degree in a high-need area (English, French, social studies, Spanish, biology, chemistry, earth science, physics, mathematics, or technology). Candidates must complete an intensive 200-hour course of study (including 40 clock hours of field experience) in a public school setting, pass two NYS teacher certification exams, and secure employment as a classroom teacher to qualify for the Transitional B teaching certificate. Candidates then finish their degree program while engaged in mentored teaching as full-time employees of a local school district.

Upon successful completion of academic program and degree conferral, Utica University makes NYSED recommendation for Initial and Professional Certification in content area, grades 7-12.

Admissions open through January 10, 2023.
Program starts on January 17, 2023.
